DAY 1 | MAY 16 | DEPART CANADA

Board your overnight flight to Budapest, Hungary.

DAY 2 | MAY 17 | ARRIVE BUDAPEST (D)

Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your hotel. Dinner at hotel.

Accommodation: Budapest Hilton Hotel or similar (2 nights)

DAY 3 | MAY 18 | BUDAPEST (B)

This morning, enjoy a half day tour. Explore the Jewish Quarter on a guided walking tour, including a visit to the iconic Dohány Street Synagogue—Europe’s largest and the second-largest in the world. Built in the 19th century for the Jewish community of Pest, the synagogue features a vast interior supported by cast iron columns, a remarkable architectural innovation of its time. Afterwards, visit the nearby Jewish Museum, which displays relics of Hungarian Jewish life and a Holocaust memorial room, and see the arcades of the Jewish Heroes’ Mausoleum and Temple honoring those who perished in the wartime ghetto.

DAY 4 | MAY 19 | BUDAPEST - EMBARKATION
(B, D)

Today, you will be transferred to pier to embark your ship.

This evening, join us for a Welcome Cocktail, followed by a specially-prepared Welcome Dinner with a spirited folklore show of local artists who dance, sing and enchant aboard.

DAY 5 | MAY 20 | BUDAPEST - ESZTERGOM
(B, L, D)

Included excursions for Golf passengers:

Discover the beautiful sights and attractions of the Hungarian capital. This morning, you will be transferred to the Pannónia Golf and Country Club, picturesquely situated in a valley bordering the Etyek wine region. In the afternoon, rejoin the ship in Esztergom just before dinner.

Budapest - Castle Hill & Historic Wonders
Discover stunning Baroque architecture, including the Hungarian State Opera and the iconic Parliament building, completed in 1904. Stop for photos at Heroes' Square, featuring monuments to Hungarian kings. Cross one of the seven bridges into Buda, visit St. Matthew's Church and Fisherman's Bastion (if open), and take in the breathtaking city views before returning to the vessel.



Pannónia Golf and Country Club

Esztergom, Visegrád castle and Szentendre
The tour starts in Budapest and takes you to Szentendre, an artists' village known for its museums and galleries, including the Margit Kovács Museum. Explore the main square, Foetér, with its cafes and shops. Next, visit the ruins of Visegrád Fortress for stunning views of the Danube Bend, followed by Esztergom, the former royal seat.

DAY 6 | MAY 21 | BRATISLAVA (B, L, D)

Included excursions for Golf passengers:

After breakfast you are transferred to the Penati Golf Club, which is situated near the town of Senica and features the longest hole in Europe. In the evening, enjoy dinner on board before the vessel departs Slovakia and crosses into Austria.

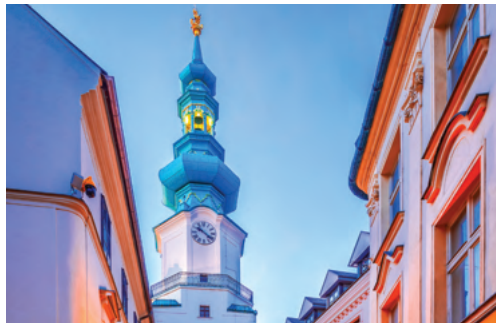

Explore the capital of Slovakia with a driving tour past St. Martin's Cathedral, Grassalkovich Palace, and up to Castle Hill for panoramic city views. Then, enjoy a guided walking tour through the old town, visiting Michael's Gate, Primatial Palace, St. Martin's Cathedral, Academia Istropolitana, and the main square with the City Hall, Opera House, and Maximilian Fountain. Stop for a treat at a cozy spot to try Pressburger rolls. The tour ends at the Opera House and Ganymede's Fountain, with free time to explore or return to the ship.

In the evening, a particularly elegant experience awaits: A waltz dance class on board, where you'll glide across the floor to the rhythm of the music and immerse yourself in the traditional Viennese dance experience.

DAY 7 | MAY 22 | VIENNA (B, L, D)

OPTIONAL EXTENSION TOUR TO BAVARIA

DAY 11 | MAY 26 | DISEMBARKATION - PASSAU - WALHALLA - REGENSBURG (B, L)

Start your Bavarian tour with a drive to Regensburg, stopping at the Walhalla monument, a Neoclassical Greek-style building above the Danube, known as the "German Pantheon." Afterward, continue to Regensburg for a 3-course lunch, followed by a walking tour of the UNESCO-listed medieval city. Highlights include the 12th-century Stone Bridge and the Gothic cathedral with twin towers. In the afternoon, check into your hotel.

DAY 12 | MAY 27 | BAVARIA EXPLORER AROUND REGENSBURG (B, L)

Spend the day exploring the Regensburg region, starting with a visit to Weltenburg Monastery, the oldest monastic settlement in Bavaria, founded around 600. The abbey church, a Baroque masterpiece, was built between 1716 and 1739. Enjoy a 3-course lunch at the world's oldest inn, family-run since 1658. Afterward, return to Regensburg for a free afternoon.

DAY 13 | MAY 28 | FROM THE DANUBE VIA MUNICH TO THE ALPS (B, D)

After breakfast, depart Regensburg for a sightseeing tour of Munich. Explore Marienplatz Square, home to the city hall, fountains, and carillon, and visit the Olympic Park, English Garden, and Nymphenburg Palace. Enjoy free time for lunch, then head to the Chiemgau region and check into your hotel in the alpine village of Inzell for a three-night stay. This picturesque area, shaped by glaciers, features rugged rocks, forests, mountain lakes, and diverse wildlife. Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 14 | MAY 29 | LAKE CHIEMSEE (B, D)

Lake Chiemsee, often called the "Bavarian Sea," covers 80 square kilometers and is set against the stunning Alpine backdrop. We'll explore the lake by boat, visiting two islands: Herren-Chiemsee, home to King Ludwig's impressive Versailles-inspired castle, and Frauen-Chiemsee, a peaceful retreat offering a break from everyday life. Frauen-Chiemsee is also a pilgrimage site, featuring a Benedictine monastery and shop, where visitors experience the island's serene, welcoming atmosphere. Dinner at hotel.



Hohen-Salzburg Fortress

DAY 15 | MAY 30 | SALZBURG (B, D)

Salzburg, meaning "Salt-Fortress," became wealthy from its salt, or "white gold." In the morning, visit the world's oldest visitor mine in Hallein to learn the story of salt through modern technology. Then, explore Salzburg's old town, birthplace of Mozart. Visit the Hohen-Salzburg Fortress, the largest fully preserved castle in Central Europe, offering panoramic views of the city. We'll take the funicular to easily reach the top and return. Dinner at hotel.

DAY 16 | MAY 31 | DEPART MUNICH (B)

After breakfast, transfer to Munich and prepare for your return flight home.
